Responsibilities & Expectations (UPDATED AS OF 11/12/20)

The onset of the COVID-19 in early 2020 has altered life for everyone. As we finalize preparations for the end of this year, the CCC Leadership and Staff are extremely excited to welcome this upcoming New Year.

In the midst of that excitement, we realize that life in the midst of COVID will require adjustments for all of us. Our commitment is to place our highest priority on the health and safety of ALL of our church family, regular attenders and visitors.

Many questions have been asked by our Staff, Members and Dream Team, as to what life will look like at CCC in an era of COVID-19. CCC's leadership, across all areas of this wonderful ministry, are working tirelessly to envision a safe and successful environment on the properties and ministries areas of our Church and our aim is to create policies and procedures in order to achieve such success.

Please understand this information is fluid and is subject to change at the discretion of CCC's leadership and it will outline our policies and procedures as they stand today.

Due to our concern to the ever-increasing numbers of COVID cases in our community and our concern for our citizens. As of Thursday, November 12th 2020 CCC would like to share the following bulletin – [**CORNERSTONE COVENANT CHURCH COVID 5on5 SAFETY PLAN**].

The first part of the plan addresses the 5 Steps each attendee is responsible for and the expectations. The second part of the plan addresses the 5 Steps CCC is responsible for and the expectations that will assist in ensure health and safety.

During this season of COVID-19 we are requesting all members & visitors when attending any service, small group function or special event to take the following safety precautions & step(s):

ATTENDEES EXPECTATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES ARE AS FOLLOWS...

1). SOCIAL DISTANCING: All attendees, when possible, maintain a distance of six feet apart when attending any and all services. Please refrain from physical touches during those times onsite services are offered.

This includes Sunday's & Wednesday's "Meet & Greet". We ask you to support the mission of "no touch" by not offering or participating in handshakes, elbow touches, hugs, fist bumps, etc.

2). MASK: All attendees (including children) are asked to wear mask to all services. Bring your own mask that suit your preference, style, type and comfort. Disposable masks are available for Onsite services for those that forget and/or have lost their mask. *[Exceptions are individuals with asthma or other respiratory-type conditions could be exempt]*

3). HANDWASHING: All attendees are asked (as soon as possible) to please utilize the Hand Sanitization Station at the doorway entrances and exits.

4). NOT FEELING WELL: All attendees, if you have COVID, or just not been feeling well, or you have a compromise immune system, please refrain from attending onsite services.

Connect us via Online services only (in the case of COVID) until you have received medical clearance.

5). OTHER SERVICES: All attendees, when participating in other services such as the In-reach Ministry of CCC (such as **Men 41 Men's Ministry**; **Far Above Rubies Women's Ministry**; **Complete Singles Ministry**; **Marriage Enrichment Ministry** **Chosen Generation Friday Fire Night**) must be aware there may be times those groups will actually...

(1). Meeting Onsite – *Please bring your mask to the onsite gathering. A disposable mask would be provided for those individuals that do not have mask.*

(2). Meeting Virtually Only – *Going to virtual meetings are not our first choice. But we ask that you stay connected and active during those critical seasons. It will bless you, the leader of those groups and encourage/strengthen community.*

(3). Meeting BOTH Onsite & Virtually.

We, in Student Ministries (including Children Church) will share any and all confirmed cases of COVID with Staff, Parents, Teachers, & Aides. (WE WILL NOT DISCLOSE NAMES). In addition, we will screen teachers and aides before serving.

ADMINISTRATIVE LEADERSHIP TEAM EXPECTATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES ARE AS FOLLOWS...

1). CLOSURES: We will close the Administrative offices on Monday's to the public for a day of deep cleaning.

2). CLEANING: We have implemented a cleaning plan for Sunday's services. (Including the deployment of our Anti-COVID 19 Steam Fog Cleaner between services to disinfect the common areas).

3). COMMITTED: We are committed to providing a Safe & Healthy worship environment. We have installed Hand Sanitization Stations throughout the Church.

We have provided mask at each entrance for those individuals that have lost and/or forgotten their mask.

4). COMMUNICATION: We, in Student Ministries (including Children Church) will share any and all confirmed cases of COVID 19 with Staff, Parents, Teachers & Aides. (*We will not disclose names*).

In addition, we will be screening teachers, students and aides with temperature checks before serving.

Signage will also be used across the CCC campus to help encourage safe practices and remind everyone of the guidelines.

5). CONSISTENCY: We also commit to consistently working on adding our Midweek services online.
